Proposed Trades and Technology Centre Important to Region

"When the Trades and Technology Centre is built, it will have a huge economic impact on the entire community!" said Evan Ortynsky at a recent meeting of the Chamber Board of Directors. As Co-Chair of the Parkland College's Campaign Cabinet, Evan is passionate about the need for the Trades and Technology Centre the Parkland College is proposing for Yorkton. "If the business community wants a highly skilled, educated labour force, then we need to invest in a Trades and Technology Centre. It will play a vital role in the economic growth of not only the city, but the Region."

For years, Yorkton and area businesses have been short of staff and especially staff with specific skills. The Centre is part of the solution for these businesses. Each year, the proposed Centre has the potential to produce 350 graduates. The economic spin-off from having 350 students in the city is profound. "We will have all these students living here, working here and spending money here," said Evan. "And if the vast majority stay in the area, as is projected, that creates a lot of opportunity for business growth."

This is the first time a regional college in Saskatchewan has undertaken the construction of a facility. This project is a result of consultations conducted with industry, business and the community about short term and long term training needs. While no one has denied the need or the value of the Centre, we must do more than support the Centre verbally. Financial support of the Centre is crucial. Of the \$14.9 million required to build the Centre, about 33% or \$4.9 million will be raised by the community. To date, the community has raised \$4 million (which includes the large donation of land by the City of Yorkton).

The Chamber urges its members to consider making some commitments to the College's Capital Campaign. No gift is too small. 
