

Did You Know?



Gord Shaw, Director of Planning & Engineering, will present a paper about Yorkton at a prestigious conference in Portland Oregon.

- Director of Planning & Engineering, Gord Shaw has been invited to present his paper Broadway -King Street Recreation Corridor Case Study at the 50th International Making Cities Livable Conference in Portland, Oregon in June. The presentation will highlight Yorkton at a prestigious international event.
- According to the Ministry of the Economy, in 2011, small businesses (those with 1 - 49 employees) accounted for 98.5% of all the businesses in Sask.
- Following the municipal election last fall, a couple of business owners indicated that while they own property and businesses in Yorkton, they live outside the city limits so were not eligible to vote in the city election. They wondered if this was a city bylaw or legislated by the province. Thanks to City Clerk, Bonnie Schenher, for the following answer: This is legislated by the province. If you own property in your personal name (not a company name) you could vote for Mayor and Council but not the school board. We do have people who meet these requirements and vote.

- · Oil production in Saskatchewan hit a new record in 2012 according to statistics recently released by the Ministry of the Economy, Crude oil production in the province reached 172.9 million barrels in 2012, up more than 7.0 per cent from the previous record of 161.0 million barrels set in 2008.
- The oil and gas industry continues to be one of the largest contributors to the Saskatchewan economy, representing about 20.7 per cent of the province's GDP.
- Sunrise Health Region is the largest employer in the area, with nearly 2,900 employees
- Between April, 2012 and January, 2013, Sunrise Health Region added 10 new physicians to the region
