

# Trades & Technology Centre to be Constructed

October 15 was an exciting day for the Parkland College, the city and east central Saskatchewan when Premier Brad Wall and the Hon. Rob Norris, Minister of Advanced Education announced that the province will contribute \$10 million to the construction of a Trades & Technology Centre in Yorkton.

The Centre will be more than 2500 square meters in size. It's anticipated that each year 360 students will graduate from the Centre and another 2000 will take upgrading.

The Yorkton Chamber has long been a supporter of the Parkland College's plans for such an expansion. The Chamber congratulates the College for its vision and determination to see this expansion become a reality. The Chamber is also grateful to the many businesses and individuals who contributed to the College's Capital Campaign which raised \$8.27 million and to the province for its contribution. The Chamber looks forward to the day the first shovel of soil is turned signalling the beginning of construction.
