

Life Member Induction

At a special Chamber Business Lunch on Sept 12, the Yorkton Chamber of Commerce proudly inducted Mrs. Ruth Shaw and Mr. Allan Bailey as Life Members of the Yorkton Chamber.

Mrs. Shaw was the Manager of the Yorkton Chamber from 1975-1997. In 1999, she received the Council of Excellence Award from the Chamber of Commerce Executives of Canada for her meritorious service to the Chamber and community. Named as Yorkton's Citizen of the Year in 1989, Mrs. Shaw has been a tireless community volunteer. One of her most successful volunteer efforts was the co-founding of the Yorkton Short Film Festival which began in 1947. In 2008, the Festival established The Ruth Shaw Award for the Best Saskatchewan Production. The first Ruth Shaw Award was presented at the 2009 Festival.

Mr. Bailey founded Bailey's Funeral Home in 1963. The company has since opened Funeral Homes in Melville and Ituna. Mr. Bailey served as President of the Yorkton Chamber of Commerce in 1967 and as a Director of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce. He is also a former Mayor and Alderman of Yorkton. Throughout his lifetime, Mr. Bailey has served as a volunteer for a number of organizations and committees and supported a variety of community projects. He was awarded the Saskatchewan Volunteer Medal in 2011.

Mrs. Shaw and Mr. Bailey join an illustrious inductee alumni. According to the Chamber's records, the first Life Member inductions occurred in 1969 when Brigadier General Alexander Ross and Howard Jackson were inducted. These were followed by George Morris (1974); G.H. (Howie) Alberts (1975); Stan Stephenson (1991); Norman Roebuck (1997); and in 1998, Keith Harper, Winnie Spence and John Miller.

According to the Chamber's constitution, Life Membership is granted to "persons who have distinguished themselves by meritorious or public service." Life Members have all the privileges of active membership, except that of holding office and are exempt from paying dues.

Life Membership is granted to the individual and not the company.

- · The Sunrise Health Region has successfully recruited a fourth full-time diagnostic sonographer. The position began September 3. A new ultrasound machine funded by donations to The Health Foundation also became operational at that time.
