Not Receiving Emails from the Chamber?

In order to be compliant with Canada's new Anti Spam Legislation (CASL) which comes into effect July 1, the Chamber has asked each person on the email list to provide consent to continue receiving the emails. Those who did not respond to the request by June 13 were stripped from the list.

If you wish to have emails from the Chamber reinstated, you must contact the Chamber by emailing info@yorktonchamber.com and indicate you consent to receiving emails from the Yorkton Chamber of Commerce.





Canola: Yorkton's "Golden" Crop

- The canola crushing plants in Yorkton, owned by Louis Dreyfuss Commodities and Richardson are each capable of processing over one million tonnes of canola per year.
- Canola is crushed for its oil. A valuable bi-product is canola meal which is fed to livestock.
- Combined, the two plants employ over 180 people.
- If the number of spin-off jobs is, on average, 7 for every job at each of the plants, then nearly 1300 jobs in Yorkton are a result of the 2 plants!



- Sask has 44% of Canada's total cultivated farmland
- In 2013, Saskatchewan had 35,270,000 seeded acres.
- In 2013, Saskatchewan farmers seeded 10,455,000 acres to canola - that's 29.6% of the province's cropped acres seeded to canola!
- Canola was developed at the University of Saskatchewan and is now grown world-wide.
- Canola oil has only 7% saturated fat - the lowest of any vegetable oil.
