# **MMRP: Cost to Your Business**

The Multi-Material Recycling Program (MMRP) is a program focusing on the packaging and paper that goes out a business's front door and home with the customer. Saskatchewan businesses or organizations that supply or distribute packaging or printed paper to

Saskatchewan households are required to register for this program, report the tonnage of packaging and paper produced or distributed, and pay fees based on that tonnage.

Administered by the Multi Material Stewardship Western (MMSW),

program goes into effect January 1, 2016. In essence, "businesses will assume responsibility for financing up to 75% of municipal net costs to operate recycling programs residential waste packaging and paper". This model is similar to one used British Columbia,

Manitoba, and Ontario. Quebec.

### **Did You Know?**

- The value of building permits issued by the City of Yorkton in 2015 equalled the value of the permits issued in 2014.
- In 2015, the City of Yorkton issued 104 new business licences!
- The business names and phone numbers of Yorkton Chamber members as of September 2015 are in the Saskatoon Chamber's Member Directory. Another way your

business gains exposure by belonging to the Yorkton Chamber of Commerce.

- The Recycling program in Yorkton began in 1994. It has evolved to the point where it is diverting recyclables in the amount of 3 million kg per year from the landfill.
- Yorkton is the only city in the province collecting recyclables and garbage once per week. In other cities, recyclable

collection is less frequent or does not exist.

• Studies have found canola increases soil organic carbon, resulting in a reduction in greenhouse gas emissions. And a comparison of canola production in Germany and the Canadian prairies found fewer emissions on the Prairies. (Source: Western Producer - Dec 24, 2015)

# **YQV Survey Results**

In late 2015, the Chamber emailed a brief survey asking its members for feedback on their perceptions of the community's knowledge about the Yorkton Regional Airport. (The Transport Canada call letters for the Airport are YQV).

When asked if they thought the Business Community is aware of the Yorkton Regional Airport, 69% responded yes while 19% responded No and 12% thought "perhaps". Some of the comments from the members were: "The Chamber has been promoting the

Airport over the past 3 years and that has helped to increase awareness"; and "The Airport Authority, prior to City Council taking it over, was just beginning to make some headway in promoting the Airport".

When asked if they thought the

Business Community understands the importance of the Airport to Yorkton, 25% of the respondents said Yes; 69% said No; and 6% thought Perhaps.

In answer to the question about how the Advantages and Benefits of



the Airport could be marketed to the people of Yorkton, the members had numerous suggestions. Topping the list was the development of a marketing strategy that uses social media. Ads in newspapers, on radio, TV and billboards were also suggested. A

unique suggestion was to have an

Aviation Career Fair at the Airport.

Developing a marketing strategy using social media also topped the list of responses in answer to the question as to how might the Airport be marketed to people outside Yorkton. Other comments

received included. "The Regina Airport Authority recognizes the importance of the Yorkton Airport. Yorkton should engage with RAA to discuss further": and "Develop the ground side land around the Airport to increase revenue and to give the Airport a fresh look."

The Chamber views the Yorkton Regional Airport as a valuable asset to both the City and the area and to the business community. The Chamber appreciates the time the members took to complete this brief survey and for the comments they provided.
