

The Yorkton Chamber is happy to report that in the House of Commons on February 1, the Prime Minister announced taxation of employer - paid health benefits will not occur. In last month's edition of *the Courier*, the Chamber urged you to send letters to our MP and the Federal Minister of Finance opposing the taxation of employer - paid health and dental care benefits. The Yorkton Chamber was one of dozens of Chambers which sent letters expressing concern about the hardship such taxation would cause employees; the administrative difficulties it would create for employers; and the future cost to the health system as preventative care declined. The Chamber thanks the many businesses which also sent letters and emails. Together, Chambers and member businesses made a difference!

InfiNET



Brian Eltom, the Assistant Vice President for Fibre to the Premise at SaskTel was the Guest Speaker at a recent Chamber Business Lunch. SaskTel's infiNET (fibre program) will begin installation in Yorkton in April. Residences will be the first to be able to access the network. It's expected businesses in Yorkton will be able to access infiNET within the next couple of years. The installation of infiNET will bring a number of contractors to the city. In turn, there will be opportunities for employment.

Health Region Update

The Yorkton Chamber of Commerce was pleased to have the Hon. Greg Ottenbreit, Minister of Rural and Remote Health, speak at a recent Business Lunch. Mr. Ottenbreit provided an update on the implementation of the single health region and described it as "a system that acts as one and is responsive to the patient". While the province will realize some savings in the reduction of regions, Mr. Ottenbreit indicated removing barriers for services between regions will be a tremendous benefit to the patients and the system. As Saskatchewan is the last province to reduce the number of regions, Mr. Ottenbreit said it has the



advantage of being able to "draw on the successes and failures of other jurisdictions". He assured the audience that the Government of Saskatchewan is committed to rural health services. The plan is to have the new Board for the Provincial Health Authority in place by the fall of 2017.
