

# Meeting with MP

Recently President Brent Murdock and Chair of the Policy committee, Mike Stackhouse and Executive Director Juanita Polegi met with Cathay Wagantall, Yorkton - Melville MP to discuss the opportunities identified in the document prepared by the Canadian Chamber of Commerce "Ten Ways to Build a Canada that Wins 2017" that are

most relevant to the Yorkton area. These include upgrading Canada's regulatory system to get natural resources and other exports to world markets; ensuring small businesses have access to the resources they require in order to grow and flourish in the global economy; assuring better access to capital for Indigenous entrepreneurs; dismantling internal trade barriers that cost consumers and disc ourage investors; and encouraging

investment by cutting the cost of doing business in this country.

Wagantall indicated that in addition to these areas she believes promoting innovation and harnessing the power of data are also important.


