Parkland Victim Services Serves 25 Years

Cheryl Tiller, Executive Director of Parkland Victim Services spoke at a recent Chamber Business Lunch. Parkland Victim Services was first organized in Yorkton 25 years ago. It's a not-for-profit organization governed by a local Board of volunteers, receiving its funding from the Ministry of Justice. Its purpose is to assist victims of crime and traumatic events. Police from 10 detachments call upon Parkland Victim Services to assist victims. It's staffed by 7 full time employees; 3 part time employees; and 29 volunteers. Between April 1 2018 and

November 8, Parkland Victim Services has assisted on 300 files.


