- Guest speakers from the Global Transportation Hub; Regina Airport Authority; Sask Health Authority; and SAMA







Deanna Bartok with the Sask Health Authority in Yorkton shared information about the Harm Reduction program at SIGN on Broadway. The program neither condones or condemns choices, but seeks to minimize the negative consequences and risk behaviours associated with substance use. Every \$1 spent on the program saves \$4 in the health care system. It does not enable drug use; it doesn't entrench addictive behaviour; and it does not increase disorder or threaten public safety & heath. Deanna indicated that SK has the highest rate of HIV and Hepatitis C infection in the country.
