Bob was selected by his fellow Directors for the Award based on his commitment to the Chamber and his attendance at Chamber meetings, events and activities. Following the meeting, Mayor Aaron Kienle delivered his first State of the City address. He shared information on a number of projects the city has recently undertaken and their progress. Some of the highlights include:

- The various tax abatement programs the city has initiated have been well received.

- 78 new Business Licences were issued in 2024 and to

date, 22 new Licences have been issued in 2025

With the federal election set for April 28, the Chamber hosted an All Candidates Forum April 22 at the Anne Portnuff Theatre. Despite the weather, several people attended the Forum to meet and listen to 4 of the candidates running in the Yorkton — Melville riding. The candidates represented the Conservative, Green, Liberal and Libertarian parties.

Questions posed to the candidates covered such topics as how, if elected, the candidate will ensure the interests of the constituents are represented; how tariffs on canola, peas and hogs will be handled; what are the plans to attract investment in the country; and how "ecological corridors" won't interfere with food production and commerce.

The floor was then turned over to the audience to ask questions of the candidates.

The women all had different stories to share about how they started their business and the unique challenges they have faced but they all agreed that they see a bright future for Yorkton with great opportunities for expansion of the business community. Town Hall on Property Assessment & Taxes

In late March, the Yorkton Chamber of Commerce held a Town Hall on Property Assessment & Taxes.

Speaking on behalf of the Sask Assessment Management Agency (SAMA), was Regional Manager Sheldon Stechyshyn(L). Yorkton is just one of the 762 urban, rural and northern municipalities for which SAMA provides its assessment services. Sheldon delivered an overview of how property assessments are calculated. Ashley Stradeski, Director of Finance for the City of Yorkton (R) described how the city sets the tax rate. It knows how much is required to run the city for the year and then determines the tax rates for various classes of property. He likened the city's tax base to a pie and that a person's (or business's) taxes is the share of the pie. Property assessments in Yorkton may be appealed until May 23 as this is a re-evaluation year.
